- Created Fascism = government ruled by a dictator who controls the people and people are not allowed to disagree with the government; severe economic and social regimentation, and forcible suppression of opposition
- Nation more important than then individual

- 1933 appointed Leader—"Fuhrer"—totalitarian established the Third Reich


Totalitarianism

| 1937 | Japan invaded China (WWII began in Asia) |
| 1938 | Munich Conference — G.B. & France appease Hitler Hitler annexed Sudetenland (German speaking portion of Czechoslovakia) |
| 1939 | Hitler annexed all of Czechoslovakia |
| 1939 | Stalin-Hitler Nonaggression Act (still enemies) Pledged they would never attack each other Agreed to split Poland (secretly) |
