# Byzantine Empire— Schism notes

## Leading up to the Schism

- Only 1 church: Catholic Church
- Pope = head of Catholic Church
  - Patriarch = in charge of eastern  $\frac{1}{2}$  of church, but still under the pope's power (Byz. emperors like to control patriarch)
- Power struggle b/w popes & Byzantine emperors
- Iconoclast Controversy:
  - 726 = Byzantine emperor forbade the use of icons b/c similar to pagan idols
    - He feared people were worshipping them as gods
  - Iconoclasts = people who broke into churches & broke icons
  - Eventually Byzantine emperors allowed the use of icons again

#### **The Schism**

- 1054 = Schism—split of Church—Roman Catholic vs.
   Eastern Orthodox
  - 1054—Pope excommunicated Patriarch, head of church in east
  - Patriarch retaliated with a similar excommunication
