		What is the type of document? (letter, book, journal, speech)
		Who does the type of document impact the author's message? (i.e. Do we use different words in speeches vs. letters? Why?)
P	Point of View	How did the author's background (race, nationality, location writing from, gender, religion, position (king, traveler, slave), socioeconomic class) impact their written perspective?
		How does the author's background impact the TONE of the document? (tone = angry, resigned, persuasive, overjoyed, depressed, authoritative)
		What broad historical themes influenced the author to create this document?
P	Purpose (MUST tie to one of the other SAPP to get credit)	Why did the author create the source? (tie to situation, audience, OR point of view)
